

**The Sultan's School Year 2 Medium Term Curriculum Plan for Art 2018-19- Information for Parents**

1	<b>Moon landing International Dot Day Art from a book</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Revise the secondary colours and learn the correct order of the colour wheel</li> <li>• Learn about the warm, cold and neutral colour groups</li> <li>• Explore the art elements of line and colour</li> <li>• Decorate artwork in a meaningful way.</li> <li>• Control a paintbrush with some accuracy.</li> <li>• Manipulate clay and imprint it with texture/stamps</li> </ul>	<p>Students will be introduced to the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the moon landing. They will look at videos of what life is like living in a rocket ship/spaceship. They will create a collaged rocket using 2D paper shapes, painted flames using different painting techniques and decorate their piece of art for effect.</p> <p>Students will then be introduced to the book 'The Dot' by Peter Reynolds. They will revise the ROYBGIV order and learn about negative and positive space in art. Students will be introduced to the book 'Stripe Island' by Tupera Tupera. Students will create a clay slab which they will section off and learn how to add texture to their clay using a variety of different tools. They will decorate using either cool or warm colours and finish with ink rubbing. They will also be introduced to optical illusion art, and look at various OI artists such as Bridget Riley. In the story there is a man with a long spiral beard.
